In accordance with the Department's <u>Mobile Phones Policy</u> issued by the Minister for Education, personal mobile phones must not be used at Richmond Primary School during school hours, including lunchtime and recess, unless an exception has been granted.

Where a student has been granted an exception, the student must use their mobile phone for the purpose for which the exception was granted, and in a safe, ethical and responsible manner.

Mobile phones owned by students at Richmond Primary School are considered valuable items and are brought to school at the owner's (student's or parent/carer's) risk. Students are encouraged not to bring a mobile phone to school unless there is a compelling reason to do so. Please note that Richmond Primary School does not have accident insurance for accidental property damage or theft. Students and their parents/carers are encouraged to obtain appropriate insurance for valuable items.

Where students bring a mobile phone to school, Richmond Primary School will provide secure storage. Secure storage is storage that cannot be readily accessed by those without permission to do so. At Richmond Primary S

• can be granted by the principal, or by the teacher for that class, in accordance with the Department's <u>Mobile Phones Policy</u>.

The three categories of exceptions allowed under the Department's <u>Mobile Phones Policy</u> are:

1 Learning-related exceptions

For students for whom a reasonable adjustment to a learning program is needed because of a disability or learning difficulty	Individual Learning Plan

2 Health and wellbeing-related exceptions

Students with a health condition	Student Health Support Plan

3. Exceptions related to managing risk when students are offsite

Travelling to and from excursions	Risk assessment planning documentation
Students on excursions and camps	Risk assessment planning documentation

Where an exception is granted, the student can only use the mobile phone for the purpose for which it was granted.

Richmond Primary School will provide students and their parents and carers with information about items that can or cannot be brought to camps, excursions, special activities and events, including personal mobile phones and smartwatches.

This policy does not apply to

- Out-of-School-Hours Care (OSHC)
- Out-of-school-hours events
- Travelling to and from school once off school grounds
